



## **ROUND 17: RADIO ALGIERS BROADCAST COMMENTARY**

Monaco drafts off of Czechoslovakia to retake the lead as Britain puts the hammer down and closes the gap into a tight third place position, his engine issuing a white smoke as he presses to the limits of his RPM. Behind, Germany comes to a stop after a full spin out, kicks the car around and accelerates back into the race – it's as if he's in a restart and it may not even be possible to catch Norway by the time the checkered flag waves. Orsi streaks by Germany, looking over his shoulder to watch the German but then glances farther back to see the rest of the pack's progress through La Trappe. Any hope that Orsi may have had in cooking the goat for a post-race celebration is certainly gone. Belgium and Norway bring up the rear, still not yet making the La Trappe curve.

**MOVEMENT KEY:**

K = in movement, refers to Braking (expending a Braking WP) to slow the car once  
 T = in movement, refers to using Tire WP when overrunning a curve, avoiding a blocking situation, etc.  
 R = in movement, refers to moving ahead one space while changing lanes to the right  
 L = in movement, refers to moving ahead one space while changing lanes to the left

**CRITICAL NOTE: THE GOAT HERD HAS RUN OFF THE TRACK – HOWEVER, THE BODY OF ONE GOAT, KILLED BY THE GERMAN RACE CAR, NOW RESTS AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE LA TRAPPE CURVE, OUTSIDE LANE.**
